**Rural Employment**

- **SGSY** - This programme was initiated in April,1999 by restructuring IRDP (Integrated Rural Development Porogramme) and a number of allied programmes such as TRYSEM ( Training of Rural Youth for Self Employment), DWCRA (Development of Women & Children in Rural Areas), SITRA (Supply of Improved Toolkits to Rural Artisans), GKY (Ganga Kalyan



Yojana) and MWS (Million Wells Schemes). This is a holistic programme covering all aspects of self-employment like organizing the poor into Self-Help Groups , training, credit, technology, infrastructure and marketing.

The objective of SGSY is to provide sustainable income to the rural poor. The programme aims at establishing a large number of micro-enterprises in the rural areas, based upon the potential of the rural people.

- **MNREGS** – The objective of MNREGS (Mahatma Gandhi Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme) is to provide livelihood security in rural areas by providing at least 100 days of guaranteed wage employment in a financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work.

- Piped Water Supply Scheme to semi - urban/urban areas –The Public Health & Engineering Department (PHED) for execution of piped water supply in urban and semi-urban areas. Water quality testing of drinking water and its remedial measures also comes under its purview. Maintenance of water supply and sanitary fitting to government building is also under the jurisdiction of the department.

The responsibility of repair/maintenance of tube wells have been given to Panchayat. Rural piped water supply scheme is being also implemented in some areas of the district like Simri village of Simri block.

The Government of India has decided that allocation of funds under IAY will be on the basis of poverty ratio and housing shortage. IAY was firstly launched during 1985-86 as a sub-scheme of RLEGP (Rural Landless Employment Guarantee Programme). This scheme, thereafter, continued as a sub-scheme of JRY (Jawahar Rojgar Yojana) since its launching in April, 1989. The scheme was delinked from JRY and made an independent scheme with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January,
